Highlights

1. Season fruit picking

Please note that the fruits and souvenirs are different depending on the time of the year.

July Departures

Peach picking (Take home two whole peaches that you chose to pick)

All-you-can-eat peaches served on plates for 20 minutes at a roadside station.

August 1~September 20

Blueberry picking and all-you-can-eat for 30 minutes.

Blueberries (50g), 1 kiwi fruit and 1 grapefruit as souvenirs.

September 21~October 20

Pick 1 whole bunch of seedless Kyoho grapes (take this home as a souvenir)

All-you-can-eat seasonal fruits served on plates for 30 minutes at Santo lida.

2. Explore Magome-juku & Tsumago-juku on the Nakasendo

Visit two former post towns on the Nakasendo, an ancient road that was one of the five main routes used to travel across Japan in the Edo Period (1603~1868). Nakasendo connected Tokyo to Kyoto and the Magome-Tsumago Trail is a well-preserved section of it.

Tsumago-juku: the restored row of houses is the most interesting aspect of this post town.

Magome-juku: the cobbled streets and precipitous terrain give this post town a unique characteristic.

Japanese Black beef sukiyaki hotpot
